

1. **First International Symposium on Borobudur Cultural Landscape Heritage: “Regional Conservation Planning”, Universitas Gadjah Mada, 20 April 2007**

a. **Program**

First International Symposium on Borobudur Cultural Landscape Heritage was attended by 90-100 participants from academic background such as students and lecturers from architectural and archaeological background as well as conservation practitioners from BP3 Special Province of Yogyakarta and Central Java, and those coming from several cities in Java. The symposium was divided in two sessions, with co-keynote speakers Mikke Susanto, Curator of Visual Art Exhibition “THE THOUSAND MYSTERIES OF BOROBUDUR” and Himachuli Gurung, Programme Specialist from UNESCO Jakarta. Discussions were held in talk shows and questions and answers session among speakers and participants led by facilitators. Generally the whole program attended by the Director of UNESCO office Jakarta Prof. Hubert Gijzen was successfully held.

2. Heritage Field School for Secondary School Teachers, 28-29 April 2007

a. Program

Heritage Field School for Secondary School Teachers was held for two days on 28-29 April 2007. The program was an introduction to Borobudur cultural landscape heritage trail aimed for secondary school teachers in Yogyakarta. There were 36 participants involved in this program. During the program all participants spend the night in local homestays in Candirejo Village. The program was commenced by heritage trail to 3 villages around Borobudur continued by lecture in Office of Borobudur Conservation, visit to Borobudur, Mendut and Pawon Temple. In the evening there were lectures on Borobudur cultural landscape and archaeological issues. On the second day all participants must attend a workshop on how to make programs of introduction to heritage based on UNESCO "Heritage in Young Hands" for their respective schools. The program was ended by program presentation by each group. Generally the program was successfully held and very well appreciated by participants.

c. Suggestions

Suggestions for UNESCO

1. Participants of the field school have less experiences or poor knowledge on Borobudur as cultural landscape heritage. On the other hand, they are supposed to share their knowledge with their students. The making of a resource kit for teachers particularly on Borobudur cultural landscape heritage will be very much appreciated by the teachers. Such kit can also be used for other temples. It is then kindly advised for UNESCO to support the kit making.
2. The field school is recommended to be held a few times a year to cover the whole secondary schools in Yogyakarta and Middle Java.
3. For the long goal, it is also recommended for teachers from all over Indonesia.
4. The lectures heritage, landscape, tangible and intangible, will be performed in the week ends in Yogyakarta prior to the site visit. Programs for teachers from outside Yogyakarta will be performed on the site in a few days.
5. Long-term target is to comprehend the teachers' kit into the national education curriculum, both as intra and extra curriculum.

Suggestions from participants

1. Lecture material constitutes additional information
2. The activity is hoped to be regular agenda for teachers
3. The program is recommended to be held in longer duration
4. Module has to be prepared and given to participants prior to the program
5. Module should be able to be a textbook and widely disseminated
6. The program is recommended to involve intangible cultural heritage such as local art performance

3. **Students Essay Competition**

The competition was commenced after the opening of Visual Art Exhibition of The Thousand Mysteries of Borobudur, on 20 April 2007. There are 4 junior high school students and 15 senior high school students participated in this competition. The judgment is focused on student's expression, messages and opinions on Borobudur during the exhibition. All participants were invited to Fun Heritage Trail held on May 6, 2007. From 19 participants, five best nominees were selected, announced during Fun Heritage Trail at Borobudur Temple.

4. Heritage Trail for Students and Journalists

a. Program

Heritage Trail for Students and Journalists was attended by 60 participants, coming from local and national scale media journalists, 17 Borobudur Essay Competition participants. All participants gathered at Jogja Gallery at 7 AM on May 6, 2007 and departed to Borobudur at 8 AM. When they arrived in Borobudur Tourist Information Center and Communication all participants were divided in two groups arranged by the organizing committee and local guides. Guided by local guide, organizing committee from Center for Heritage Conservation and Senthir, the participants rode on horse carriage to visit three villages, Tuk Songo, Tanjungsari and Klipoh villages. After the 3 village trail, all participants headed to Candirejo village to have lunch and take a abreak. After lunch all participants departed to visit Borobudur

Temple and the final destination was a visit to remains of ancient lake in Elo river led by Mr. Helmy Murwanto, a geologist from Universitas Pembangunan Nasional Yogyakarta.

d. Suggestions

1. The essay competition as an attempt of building the heritage awareness among the students is recommended to be held quite often. The activity can be performed prior to the site visit or after the visit.
2. The trail would be more effective for the students and the local people if it is operated by the local people. In the case, there will be direct communication among the students who happen to know very little about the temple and its environment as well as the local culture, and the local people.
3. Such trail is also necessary for students from the villages around Borobudur for they might not really know their own heirloom since the knowledge about heritage conservation has just started to spread. In order to encourage the local students, the event could be performed altogether with students from outside Borobudur. In this way the local students will be inspired how other students think and find the Borobudur and the living culture around it.
4. The activities could be performed in various way such as painting, drawing, writing, and presenting the essays, in order to give them various choice in learning about the heritage.
5. The trail is also recommended for foreign students.

5. CONCLUSION

Borobudur is a wealthy source for a comprehensive cultural knowledge. It is indeed a center of excellence for education, and the right place for cultural field school as well. Borobudur is an affluent educative tourism. With all these prolific points it is important to hold the field school continuously in order to spread out the knowledge on heritage and the spirit of conserving the Borobudur.
