Jogja has many patterns of Batik such as *Wahyu Tumurun* which actually means inherited revelations that used in a traditional occasion of bride-groom meeting. The geometric pattern of *Batik Kawung* represents the heroic and justice that brought by the King or Noble. While *Batik Nitik* applies leave, stem and flower shapes to put blue color among white and brown. Jogja has many more style of Batik that each one has its own philosophy.

Jogja is a special region that preserve its tradition. The special region that full of educations, histories, cultures, crafts and tourism. I participate myself on preserving this culture. However, it is not about the position as Queen Consort or as a member of Indonesian Senate that put me into this activity. It is about empowerment of people, empowerment of woman, and also empowerment of small and medium enterprises. It is how we encourage the people of Jogja to explore the cultural tradition and spirit in craftmanship and also aesthetical touch. It is actually preserved in the mind and heart of people. And I am actually, also one of them.

In this beautiful occasion, I also want to promote the cooperation among all cultures over the world. I see Mr. Ong and Mr. Tang, from our fellows ASEAN Countries, and Madame Mahayastra who encourage Balinese to stand up straight and proud to overcome the negative impact of Pandemic. There are also many fellows from other countries that join this virtual seminar. We are surely need cooperation to save this cultural legacy. Each country and each city have their own specialty. Each one has specific characteristic that can be appreciated by other people. Malaysian and Vietnamese may come to Indonesia and to Jogja to start an art exhibition, as well as Indonesian can see the beautiful art and crafting from Malaysia and Vietnam.

Allows us to swipe the differences aside, let us put technical difficulties as the tail business, bring ourselves to the meeting round table so we can discuss more detail about cooperating events, and good business relations. I encourage people of Jogja and those of Indonesia to start cooperation as soon as possible.

I believe we have a lot of time to discuss about crafting and batik. We also have a lot of time to establish good collaboration in this business. I am not really sure when will this pandemic end, and when will all the participant in this virtual forum can see Jogja in person.
